• fall semester 2021/22: June 10th 2021

• spring semester 2022: December 10th 2021

ACCOMMODATION

Room reservations for exchange students are managed by the International Office based on the **application form signed by the student**. If there are no rooms are available in our dormitories, we will inform the students in time, so they can rent a private room.

VISA

EU citizens do **not need a visa**. **Non-EU citizens** have to apply for a **student visa** in their country of origin (at the German embassy) before moving to Germany.

INSURANCE

Students from EU countries only need to present their **EU** health insurance card. Non-EU students need a travel insurance and after arriving to Germany, they have to register for a **German health insurance for students** which costs approx. **110€** per month.

AVERAGE COST OF LIVING

The monthly budget for studying in Germany (includes food, accommodation, transport and leisure activities) amounts to approx. **861€**. **Non-EU students** need a **blocked account** or a commitment of a third party.

SEMESTER FEE

Currently, the **mandatory** semester fee amounts to **334,38€ (Gelsenkirchen** and **Recklinghausen)**, and **312,40€ (Bocholt)**, including the ticket for the use of the public transfer in North-Rhine Westphalia.
